

Subj: REVIEW OF NAVAL RECORD ICO [REDACTED]

f. On 4 October 2022, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Reenlistment request was submitted, and approved by Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps on 23 November 2022 and on 9 October 2022, Petitioner entered Zone C. On 6 December 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years and 10 months with an ECC of 5 October 2027, and received a Zone C SRB and was promoted to Gunnery Sergeant/E-7 on 1 January 2023.

g. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner began routing a 48-month reenlistment with Zone B SRB in July 2022 and it was endorsed by his Unit Commander on 27 July 2022. Due to processing time and at no fault of Petitioner, he reenlisted on 6 December 2022, after crossing into Zone C and received a Zone C SRB for \$27,500. Adjusting Petitioner's reenlistment to 7 October 2022 will authorize him to receive the FY23 Zone B SRB in the amount of \$51,300, less the money already received to date.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on "6/7 October 2022" vice "5/6 December 2022" for a term of "5 years" vice "4 years and 10 months." Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone "B" SRB for MOS 021 ILM, E-6 and above which is capped at \$51,300 for 48 months of additional obligated service. Remaining obligated service to 20 September 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation.

That a copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
