- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to reflect date of entry on active duty as 1 August 1986 vice 31 July 1990 on DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty ending on 16 July 1993.
- 2. The Board, consisting of previous particles, and previous Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 14 December 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:
- a. On 30 August 1985, Petitioner enlisted in U.S. Navy Reserve for 8 years of which 4 years was considered an active duty obligation.
- b. On 1 August 1986, Petitioner entered active duty and signed a 24-month extension on 16 February 1989.
- c. On 30 July 1990, Petitioner discharged for immediate reenlistment. Petitioner's official military personnel file does not reflect that a DD Form 214 was issued for the active duty period of 1 August 1986 to 30 July 1990.
 - d. On 31 July 1990, Petitioner reenlisted in U.S. Navy for 4 years.

e. On 16 July 1993, Petitioner discharged and issued DD Form 214 for active duty period of 31 July 1990 to 16 July 1993; total prior active duty service captured as 3 years, 11 months, and 29 days.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded there is no evidence Petitioner was issued DD Form 214 for active duty service of 1 August 1986 to 30 July 1990 in accordance with reference (b). However, determined that per reference (c), the aforementioned period should not be included on the DD Form 214 ending on 16 July 1993. Therefore, the Board determined that under this circumstance, partial relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner issued DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty for the period of 1 August 1986 to 30 July 1990.

The part of Petitioner's request for corrective action that exceeds the foregoing is denied in accordance with references (b) and (c). Active duty service period captured on DD Form 214 ending on 16 July 1993 is correct.

That a copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.



¹ Reference (b), the DD Form 214 will be prepared and furnished to members while serving on active duty when they have a change of status or component such as enlisted personnel discharged for the purpose of immediate enlistment or reenlistment.

² Reference (c) ended the authorization to issue a DD Form 214 to members discharged for the purpose of immediate reenlistment in the Navy on 28 June 1993.
