

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 31 July 2021 for 3 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of _______, and ______ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 2 November 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 2 July 2014, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 1 July 2018 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 1 July 2020; "Training in the nuclear field program, and advancement to E-4 per MILPERSMAN 1160-040, 11160-080 and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution and thereafter may not be canceled except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E-4, 12 months of the agreement may not be canceled whether or not I complete nuclear power or advanced training."



l. In May 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC N41Z. In June 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A.

- m. In accordance with reference (d), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 004/FY21) a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 7.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S rate/NEC was listed.
- n. On 3 December 2021, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/Electronic Service Record (ESR) shows a 11-month agreement to extend enlistment with a SEAOS of 14 April 2024.
- o. On 9 February 2022, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 11 months with a SEAOS of 14 March 2025 in order to match EAOS with PRD of 1 April 2024.
 - p. In October 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC 8MTS.
- q. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 2 July 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B. On 19 October 2020, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: with required obligated service to January 2024. On 12 November 2020, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: with required obligated service to April 2024. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c). On 3 December 2021, Navy NSIPS/ESR shows a 11-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 31 July 2021, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 11-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 15 May 2023 is null and void.

Petitioner's 11-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 9 February 2022 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 12 November 2020 agreeing to extend enlistment for 11 months for OBLISERV to April 2024.

Petitioner was discharged 30 July 2021 and reenlisted on 31 July 2021 for a term of 3 years.

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Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "7.0" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14S rate/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 14 May 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected. Contact Assistant concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
