1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 20 October 2021 for 4 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 26 October 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 19 October 2015, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 18 October 2019 and Soft EAOS (SEAOs) of 18 October 2021; "Training in the Nuclear Field Program and advancement to E4 per MILPERSMAN Articles 1160-040 and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN Article 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

b. On 18 October 2017, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2917) while stationed in ██████████ with an effective date of departure of November 2017. Petitioner's ultimate activity was ██████████ for duty with an effective date of arrival of 1 December 2017 with a projected rotation date (PRD) of December 2021.

c. On 31 May 2018, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 30 May 2024 and received a Zone A SRB.

d. In November 2017, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N14O.

e. On 3 November 2017, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 30 November 2017 for duty.

f. In June 2018, Petitioner was awarded NEC N41Z.

g. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Duty and Full-Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

h. In October 2020, Petitioner was awarded NEC N14S. In August 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC N33Z.

i. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 7.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S rate/NEC was listed.

j. On 19 October 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B.

k. On 26 October 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2991) with required obligated service to June 2025, while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of February 2022. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 7 March 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 14 June 2022 with a PRD of June 2025.

l. On 31 January 2022, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2991) with required obligated service to May 2025, while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of March 2022. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 16 April 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 9 May 2022 with a PRD of May 2025.

m. On 31 March 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 17 April 2022 for temporary duty.

n. In May 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A.

o. On 5 May 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 6 May 2022 for duty.

p. On 6 May 2022, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account shows that Petitioner's Submarine Pay stopped.

q. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 19 October 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B and at that time a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c). At that time, Petitioner's EAOS was 30 May 2024. However, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist on 20 October 2021 for 4 years in accordance with reference (b), and receive a Zone B SRB.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged 19 October 2021 and reenlisted on 20 October 2021 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "7.0" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14S rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 30 May 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected. Contact Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, [REDACTED] concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
