




Instructor, between 2017 and 2020, which were available for the promotion selection board's consideration. Furthermore, the Board noted that, although the promotion board precept charges members of the board to consider Marines who are assigned to or have successfully completed a Type 1 billet (0913) to be considered as "highly qualified" for promotion, pursuant to MCO P1400.32D (ENLPROMMAN), the Board is still responsible for selecting Marines who are determined by a majority vote to be the most qualified amongst their peers for selection. Thus, the Board determined that you were properly considered but not selected for promotion to GySgt by the FY 2020 and FY 2021 promotion selection boards. The Board therefore concluded that there is no probable material error, substantive inaccuracy, or injustice warranting a FY21 and FY22 ERSB. Accordingly, given the totality of the circumstances, the Board determined that your request does not merit relief.

It is regretted that the circumstances of your case are such that favorable action cannot be taken. You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
