- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show Petitioner reenlisted on 21 March 2022 for 3 years and was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, and ______ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 30 November 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Petitioner was discharged with an Uncharacterized (Entry Level Separation) character of service and was issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 14 August 2013 to 10 October 2013 due to erroneous entry.
- b. On 13 May 2015, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 12 May 2019 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 12 May 2021; "Training in the Nuclear Field, MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500, 1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be canceled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 16 March 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B. On 21 June 2021, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 1721 with required obligated service to August 2024. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c). On 27 September 2021, NSIPS/ESR shows agreements to extend enlistment for 5 months to meet the OBLISERV. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 21 March 2022, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 5-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 20 February 2024 is null and void. Note: Any other agreement to extend enlistment to the total aggregate of 11 months is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 27 September 2021 agreeing to extend enlistment for 11 months for OBLISERV to January 2025.

Petitioner was discharged on 20 March 2022 and reenlisted on 21 March 2022 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SW)/N24O rate/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 19 February 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected. Contact Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
