- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 15 January 2023 for 3 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, and ______ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 21 November 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 14 October 2015, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 13 October 2019 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 13 October 2021; "Training in the Nuclear Field Program and advancement to E4 per MILPERSMAN Articles 1160-040 and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN Article 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

- n. In accordance with reference (d), FY23 SRB Award Plan (N13 SRB 001/FY23), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N25O/S rate/NEC was listed.
- o. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 17 February 2021, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 0481 with required obligated service to January 2025. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 9 August 2021, NSIPS/ESR shows an 8-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. On 14 October 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 15 January 2023, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 8-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 25 May 2024 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 9 August 2021 agreeing to extend enlistment for 8 months for OBLISERV to January 2025.

Petitioner was discharged 14 January 2023 and reenlisted on 15 January 2023 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW) N25S, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 24 May 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected. Contact Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, LT ... concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
