- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 8 May 2023 for 4 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, _____, and ______ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 30 January 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 27 April 2017, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 26 April 2021 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 26 April 2023; "Training in the Nudear Field. MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500, 1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and .1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12

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	ns of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or need Training."
b.	In March 2019, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N24O.
	On 13 December 2019, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 12 December and received a Zone A SRB.
d.	On 2 April 2019, Petitioner transferred from on 24 April 2019 for duty.
Active have 272/1	In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for e Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 9), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in enlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.
"B" S	In accordance with reference (c), FY23 SRB Award Plan (N13 SRB 001/FY23), a Zone RB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SW)/N24O/S NEC was listed.

Oner's ultimate activity was for with an effective date of arrival of 15 June 2023 with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of 2026. Obligated service to April 2026 is required for this assignment which may be deed by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary ander critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of PERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.

k. In accordance with reference (d), FY23 SRB Award Plan (N13 SRB 002/FY23), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SW)/N24O/S rate/NEC was listed.

- 1. On 27 April 2023, Petitioner entered Zone B.
- m. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 15 November 2022, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 3192 with required obligated service to April 2026. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 20 November 2022, NSIPS/ESR shows a 4-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. On 27 April 2023, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 8 May 2023, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 4-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 13 December 2025 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 20 November 2022 agreeing to extend enlistment for 4 months for OBLISERV to April 2026.

Petitioner was discharged 7 May 2023 and reenlisted on 8 May 2023 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SW)/N24O rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 12 December 2025 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA).

at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, concerning SRB payment.

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A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
