- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 20 June 2020 for 5 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of allegations of error and injustice on 6 February 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 17 June 2014, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 16 June 2018 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 16 June 2020; "Training in the Nuclear Field. MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500, 1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this

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agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."
b. On 8 June 2016, Petitioner transferred from on 10 June 2016 for duty.
c. In February 2017, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N54Z and 766A.
d. On 18 May 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 17 May 2023 and received a Zone A SRB.
e. In December 2018, Petitioner was awarded NEC N14S.
f. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB award levels and reenlistment policy for Active Duty and Full Time Support, updates to the pay for performance pilot (a Sailor 2025 initiative) and changes to how future SRB award levels will be announced. SRB award levels and reenlistment policy listed in this NAVADMIN superseded those contained in NAVADMIN 129/19. Sailors must have reenlisted within 270-days of their EAOS, except in the following cases: Nuclear-trained Sailors. Sailors who must obligate service (OBLISERV) to execute a permanent change of station move were allowed to reenlist early any time within 1 Calendar Year of the detachment month, but not later than the date of detachment from the last intermediate duty station. Commands were required to submit SRB reenlistment requests to BUPERS-328 via Officer Personnel Information System or Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System 35 to 120 days in advance of the requested reenlistment date of the Sailor. Requests submitted less than 35 days prior to the requested reenlistment date would be rejected. However, commands may contact BUPERS-328 for waiver eligibility and procedures. Sailors must have had an approved SRB request before reenlisting. Furthermore, a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 5.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S rate/NEC was authorized.
g. On 2 January 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0020) with required obligated service to November 2023, while stationed in with an effective date of departure of June 2020. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 27 July 2020. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 15 November 2020 with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of November 2023. Obligated service to November 2023 is required for this assignment which may be satisfied by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to

h. On 25 February 2020, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0020) with required obligated service to November 2023, while stationed in

i. On 17 March 2020, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 24 months with SEAOS of 17 May 2025 in order to incur sufficient obligated service to execute BUPERS rder: 0020.
j. In accordance with reference (c), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now ave reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 72/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.
k. In accordance with reference (d), FY20 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 003/FY20), a Zone B" SRB with an award level of 7.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S ate/NEC was listed.
1. On 17 June 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B.
m. On 20 June 2020, Petitioner transferred from an entire on 28 July 2020 for temporary duty.
n. On 14 November 2020, Petitioner transferred from on 14 November 2020 for duty.
o. In February 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A. In May 2022, Petitioner was warded NEC N33Z.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 2 January 2020, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 0020 with required obligated service to November 2023. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (b), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 17 March 2020, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 24 months to meet the OBLISERV. On 15 April 2020, reference (c) was published, authorizing nuclear trained sailors to reenlist any time within the reenlistment Zone. On 17 June 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 20 June 2020, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 5 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 24-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 17 March 2020 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 17 March 2020 agreeing to extend enlistment for 24 months for OBLISERV to November 2023.

Petitioner was discharged 19 June 2020 and reenlisted on 20 June 2020 for a term of 5 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "7.0" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14S rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 17 May 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA).

: N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
