1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 25 June 2023 for 3 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of **Sector** reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 21 December 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 22 June 2016, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 21 June 2020 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 21 June 2022; "Training in the nuclear field. MILPERSMAN 1530-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500, 1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to rate and grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete nuclear power or advanced training."

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c. On 21 May 2018, Petitioner transferred from on 21 May 2018 for duty. , and arrived to

d. On 17 October 2018, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 16 October 2024 and received a Zone A SRB.

e. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

f. In August 2020, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N15S.

g. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15O/S rate/NEC was listed.

h. On 18 November 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 3221) with required obligated service to August 2025, while stationed in

with an effective date of departure of April 2022. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was **and the effective** for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 2 May 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was **and the effective** date of arrival of 20 August 2022 with a PRD of August 2025. Obligated service to August 2025 is required for this assignment, which may be satisfied, by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.

i. On 3 March 2022, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 8 months with an SEAOS of 16 June 2025 in order to incur obligated service to execute BUPERS order 3221.

j. On 8 April 2022, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account shows that Petitioner's Submarine Pay stopped.

k. On 8 April 2022, Petitioner transferred from **1999**, and arrived to **1999** on 2 May 2022 for temporary duty.

1. On 22 June 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B.

m. On 20 August 2022, Petitioner transferred from 20 August 2022 for duty.

n. In accordance with reference (d), FY23 SRB Award Plan (N13 SRB 002/FY23), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15O/S rate/NEC was listed.

o. In July 2023, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 18 November 2021, Petitioner was issued official BUPERS order: 3221 with required obligated service to August 2025. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in zone A. On 3 March 2022, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 8 months to meet the OBLISERV. On 22 June 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 25 June 2023, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 8-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 3 March 2022 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 3 March 2022 agreeing to extend enlistment for 10 months for OBLISERV to August 2025.

Petitioner was discharged 24 June 2023 and reenlisted on 25 June 2023 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15S rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 16 October 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected. Contact Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, . concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
