- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 14 April 2023 for 4 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, _____, and _____ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 13 February 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 11 April 2017, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 10 April 2021 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 10 April 2023; "Training in the Nuclear Field. MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500, 1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be canceled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 29 August 2022, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: with required obligated service to March 2026. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 4 January 2023, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 6 months to meet the OBLISERV. On 11 April 2023, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 14 April 2023, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 6-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 4 January 2023 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 4 January 2023 agreeing to extend enlistment for 6 months for OBLISERV to March 2026.

Petitioner was discharged 13 April 2023 and reenlisted on 14 April 2023 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15S rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 1 September 2025 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA).

at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
