1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 14 July 2022 for 4 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 21 December 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 13 July 2016, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 12 July 2020 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 12 July 2022; "Training in the Nuclear Field Program, and advancement to E-4. Per MILPERSMAN Articles 1160-040 and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be canceled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN Article 1160-040. In particular, I understand that, when I accept advancement to E-4, 12 months of this agreement may not be canceled, whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

- b. On 22 May 2018, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 20 June 2018 for duty.
- c. On 5 October 2018, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 4 October 2024 and received a Zone A SRB.
- d. In February 2019, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) 752B.
- e. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.
- f. In February 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC N14S.
- g. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone “B” SRB with an award level of 7.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S rate/NEC was listed.
- h. On 18 November 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 3221) with required obligated service to December 2025, while stationed in [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of June 2022. Petitioner’s intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 10 July 2022. Petitioner’s ultimate activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 1 December 2022 with a Projected Rotation Date of December 2025. Obligated service to December 2025 is required for this assignment, which may be satisfied, by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.
- i. On 11 January 2022, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/Electronic Service Record (ESR) shows a 14-month agreement to extend enlistment with an SEAOS of 4 December 2025.
- j. In April 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC N33Z.
- k. On 10 June 2022, Petitioner’s Master Military Pay Account shows that Petitioner’s Submarine Pay stopped.
- l. On 10 June 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 11 July 2022 for duty.

m. In accordance with reference (d), FY22 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 003/FY22), a Zone “B” SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S rate/NEC was listed.

n. On 13 July 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B.

o. In November 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC N76Z.

p. On 9 November 2022, Petitioner transferred from FMRSD & RCTQS, and arrived to NRMD PAC on 30 November 2022 for duty.

q. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner’s application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 18 November 2021, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 3221 with required obligated service to December 2025. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in zone A. On 11 January 2022, NSIPS/ESR shows a 14-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. On 13 July 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 14 July 2022, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner’s naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner’s 14-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 5 October 2024 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 11 January 2022 agreeing to extend enlistment for 14 months for OBLISERV to December 2025.

Petitioner was discharged 13 July 2022 and reenlisted on 14 July 2022 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone “B” SRB with an award level of “8.5” (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14S rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 4 October 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board’s recommendation be corrected. Contact Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, [REDACTED], [REDACTED], concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner’s naval record.
