1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show Petitioner reenlisted on 5 April 2022 for 4 years and was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 4 January 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
 - a. On 30 March 2016, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 29 March 2020 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 29 March 2022; "Nuclear Field (NF 6YO) Program."
 - b. In April 2018, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N230.
 - c. On 4 April 2018, Petitioner transferred from ██████████, and arrived to ██████████ on 23 April 2018 for duty.
 - d. On 4 October 2018, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 3 October 2024 and received a Zone A SRB.

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e. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

f. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the ETN(SW)/N23O/S rate/NEC was listed.

g. On 8 November 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]) with required obligated service to July 2025, while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of March 2022. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 4 April 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 23 July 2022 with a Projected Rotation Date of July 2025. Obligated service to July 2025 is required for this assignment, which may be satisfied, by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.

h. On 9 November 2021, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/Electronic Service Record (ESR) shows a 9-month agreement to extend enlistment with an SEAOS of 3 July 2025.

i. In accordance with reference (d), FY22 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 001/FY22), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the ETN(SW)/N23O/S rate/NEC was listed.

j. On 11 March 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 5 April 2022 for temporary duty.

k. On 30 March 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B.

l. On 23 July 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] and arrived to [REDACTED] on 23 July 2022 for duty.

m. In October 2023, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 8 November 2021, Petitioner was issued official BUPERS order: [REDACTED] with required obligated service to July 2025. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 9 November 2021, NSIPS/ESR shows a 9-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. On 30 March 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 5 April 2022, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

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RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 9-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 4 October 2024 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 9 November 2021 agreeing to extend enlistment for 9 months for OBLISERV to July 2025.

Petitioner was discharged on 4 April 2022 and reenlisted on 5 April 2022 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the ETN(SW)/N23O rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 3 October 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected. Contact Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, [REDACTED] concerning SRB payment.

That a copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
