Dear █,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 1 February 2024. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion contained in Branch Head, Community Management Support Branch memorandum 1160 Ser B328/186 of 14 November 2023, which was previously provided to you for comment.

On 16 March 2017, you entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 15 March 2021 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 15 March 2023.

In accordance with NAVADMIN 108/20 published on 15 Apr 20, this NAVADMIN announced revised Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

On 10 December 2021, you were issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 3441) with required obligated service to January 2028, while stationed in █ with an effective date of departure of March 2022. Your intermediate (01) activity was █ █ for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 14 May 2022. Your intermediate (02) activity was █ █ for temporary duty with an effective date of arrival of 28 May 2022. Your intermediate (03) activity was █ █ for temporary duty under instruction with an

effective date of arrival of 4 June 2022. Your intermediate (04) activity was █ for temporary duty with an effective date of arrival of 3 July 2022.

Your ultimate activity was █ for duty with an effective date of arrival of 15 January 2023 with a Projected Rotation Date of January 2028. Obligated service to January 2028 is required for this assignment which may be satisfied by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.

On 26 April 2022, you reenlisted for 2 years with an EAOS of 25 April 2024.

On 2 May 2022, you transferred from █, and arrived to █ on 14 May 2022 for temporary duty. On 4 June 2022, you transferred from █, and arrived to █ on 5 June 2022 for temporary duty. On 1 July 2022, you transferred from █, and arrived to █ on 6 July 2022 for temporary duty. On 18 November 2022, you transferred from █, and arrived to █ on 1 December 2022 for duty.

On 16 March 2023, you entered Zone B.

You requested a reenlistment contract for 60 months effective 16 March 2023 a Zone B SRB to replace your 24-month reenlistment executed on 26 April 2022, the Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. However, the Board concluded that BUPERS order: 3441 required obligated service to January 2028. On 26 April 2022, you reenlisted for 2 years with an EAOS of 25 April 2024, 45 months short of the required OBLISERV out to January 2028. You entered Zone B on 16 March 2023. Per NAVADMIN 108/20, to be eligible to reenlist for SRB, your reenlistment must be within 365 days of your EAOS. The Board concluded that you have been eligible to reenlist in Zone B since 26 April 2023. Currently, skillset Zone B, CTT/771B offers an SRB. You should coordinate with your Command Career Counselor on your career options. In this connection, the Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the advisory opinion.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
