1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to reflect date entered active duty service in 1958 vice 1962 on his DD Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge ending 10 December 1962.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 13 February 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 17 December 1958, Petitioner enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps for 6-years and entered active duty.

b. Petitioner reported as unauthorized absence from 20 March 1961 to 23 March 1961 and 5 September 1961 to 8 September 1961; end of obligated service changed to 22 December 1964.

c. On 10 December 1962, Petitioner was released from active duty and transferred to the Marine Corps Reserve to complete his military service obligation. DD Form 214 issued with invalid period of active duty service from 17 December 1962 to 10 December 1962.

d. On 22 December 1964, Petitioner discharged from the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. Petitioner's record reflects sufficient evidence to reflect he entered active duty on 17 December 1958. Therefore, the Board agreed that under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge ending 10 December 1962 is amended to reflect Block 19c (Date of Entry) "17 December 1958" vice "17 December 1962." Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected. Note: Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps will issue a DD Form 215 or a new DD Form 214 whichever one they deem appropriate.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
