- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting consideration for the Sergeant Major through Master Sergeant Promotion Selection Board (PSB) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022.
- 2. The Board, consisting of provided provided provided provided provided Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 8 February 2024, and pursuant to its regulations, determined the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulation within the Department of the Navy.
- b. Due to Petitioner's date of rank (DOR) to Gunnery Sergeant being reflected as 1 July 2019 vice 1 July 2018, he was not considered in zone for promotion on the FY 2022 Sergeant Major through Master Sergeant PSB. Upon correction of his DOR and per reference (b), Petitioner should have been considered in zone for promotion on the FY 2022 Sergeant Major through Master Sergeant PSB.
- c. By memorandum of 1 February 2024, MMPB-11's Advisory Opinion (AO) at enclosure (2) recommends Petitioner receive remedial consideration for the FY 2022 Sergeant Major through Master Sergeant PSB.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an

error warranting corrective action. In this regard, the Board, relying on the AO, determined Petitioner should be granted remedial promotion consideration by the FY 2022 Sergeant Major through Master Sergeant PSB.

RECOMMENDATION

In view of the above, the Board recommends the following corrective action.

HQMC convene an Enlisted Remedial Selection Board to consider Petitioner for selection by the FY 2022 Sergeant Major through Master Sergeant PSB.

- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulation, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
