APPLICANT'S REQUEST

The Board reconsider his request that his reentry (RE) code of 6H (Pending discharge-involuntary) be changed to a code that would allow him to reenlist.

RESUME OF THE CASE

The applicant is a former Air National Guard (ANG) airman first class (E-3).

On 21 June 2016, the Board considered and denied the applicant's request that his reentry (RE) code of 6H be changed to a code that would allow him to reenlist; finding the prior request was not timely submitted.

For an accounting of the applicant's original request and the rationale of the earlier decision, see the AFBCMR Letter and redacted copy of the Record of Proceedings at Exhibit F.

On 18 July 2022, the applicant requested reconsideration of his request. He again contends he was advised verbally and in writing that he could reenlist once his credit was in order.

In support of his reconsideration request, the applicant submitted the following new evidence: (1) Memorandum – Acknowledgement of Rights, dated 20 November 2009; (2) Memorandum – Receipt of Notification of Action Under AFI 36-3209, dated 20 November 2009; and (3) Letter from OIC Manpower and Personnel Flight.

The applicant's complete submission is at Exhibit L.

AIR FORCE EVALUATION

NGB/A1PP recommends denying the application. On 27 August 2008, the applicant's security clearance was denied due to excessive debt and outstanding payments, and consequently the applicant could not attend initial active duty training. He was recommended for discharge for entry level performance and conduct under AFI 36-3209 paragraph 3.16.3 – failure to report for scheduled initial active duty training within 365 days of enlistment.

Based on the documentation provided by the applicant and analysis of the facts, there is no evidence of an error or injustice. The unit appropriately discharged the applicant IAW AFI 36-3209, paragraph 3.16.3 – failure to report for scheduled initial active duty training within 365 days

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of enlistment, with a RE code of 6H which is the most appropriate RE code given the applicant was involuntarily separated.

APPLICANT'S REVIEW OF AIR FORCE EVALUATION

The Board sent a copy of the advisory opinion to the applicant on 11 October 2022 for comment (Exhibit O) but has received no response.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION


- 1. The application was timely filed.
- 2. The applicant exhausted all available non-judicial relief before applying to the Board.
- 3. After reviewing all Exhibits, the Board remains unconvinced the evidence presented demonstrates an error or injustice. The Board concurs with the rationale and recommendation of NGB/A1PP and finds a preponderance of the evidence does not substantiate the applicant's contentions. Therefore, the Board recommends against correcting the applicant's records.

RECOMMENDATION

The Board recommends informing the applicant the evidence did not demonstrate material error or injustice, and the Board will reconsider the application only upon receipt of relevant evidence not already presented.

CERTIFICATION
