### APPLICANT'S REQUEST

The date of birth (DOB) on his DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty, be corrected.

## APPLICANT'S CONTENTIONS

He needs this document to be correct so it would be in order with the new guidelines that are required.

The applicant's complete submission is at Exhibit A.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The applicant is a former Air Force staff sergeant (E-5).

The applicant served in the Air Force from 3 Jun 77 to 2 Sep 82, with a DOB recorded differently than the DOB on his DD Form 214.

According to the certified Certificate of Naturalization and certified birth certificate provided by the applicant, the DOB is different from the DOB on the applicant's DD Form 214.

#### APPLICABLE AUTHORITY/GUIDANCE

AFI 36-2608, *Military Personnel Records System*, Table A7.5 (Correction to Date of Birth), Note 3, provides as follows: Do not correct records of former members unless evidence proves the date of birth used while serving with the Air Force was erroneously recorded. Required proof is an unaltered original document from the jurisdiction of the applicant's birth, showing the applicant's name and date of birth.

# FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

- 1. The application was not timely filed, but it is in the interest of justice to excuse the delay.
- 2. The applicant exhausted all available non-judicial relief before applying to the Board.

3. After reviewing all Exhibits, the Board concludes the applicant is the victim of an error. The Board finds the applicant's date of birth used while serving with the Air Force was erroneously recorded. Therefore, the Board recommends correcting the applicant's records as indicated below.

#### RECOMMENDATION

The pertinent military records of the Department of the Air Force relating to APPLICANT be corrected to show that the DD Form 214, *Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty*, issued in conjunction with the 2 Sep 82 discharge, be changed to reflect the correct DOB in Block 5.
