APPLICANT'S REQUEST

He be credited with one (1) year of satisfactory service for his retention/retirement (R/R) year 7 May 21 to 6 May 22.

APPLICANT'S CONTENTIONS

He is requesting to be granted a satisfactory year for 2021 to 2022 because he completed all of his requirements based on the information he was provided by his servicing detachment. On 15 Apr 21, he transferred from Active Duty to the Air Force Reserve; however, he was not assigned until 7 Dec 21. He was counseled by his servicing detachment that his R/R date was 2 Feb to 1 Feb. On 16 Sep 22, after he attempted to correct his records his R/R date was adjusted to reflect 7 May 21 to 6 May 22. He received a bad year for 2021 to 2022 because he now understands he was miscounseled and scheduled duty around his work to fall within the 2 Feb 21 to 1 Feb 22 R/R year.

The applicant's complete submission is at Exhibit A.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The applicant is an Air Force Reserve major (O-4).

On 14 Apr 21, according to DD Form 214, *Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty*, the applicant resigned from the Regular Air Force and was credited with 10 years, 6 months, and 3 days of active service.

On 15 Apr 21, according to Reserve Order XX-XXX, dated 17 Jun 21, the applicant was appointed to the Air Force Reserve.

According to the Point Credit Accounting and Reporting System (PCARS) report, the applicant was credited with the with the following Active Duty (AD), Inactive Duty for Training (IDT), membership (MBR), and retirement points from 2021 to 2022:

AIR FORCE EVALUATION

HQ RIO/IRO recommends granting the application. The applicant is requesting to have his R/R year from 7 May 2021 to 6 May 2022 corrected from unsatisfactory to satisfactory due to inaccurate information provided when transferring from active duty to the Air Force Reserve. The applicant provided documentation that reflects his R/R date was 2 Feb 21 to 1 Feb 22, when he initially transferred to the Air Force Reserve. On 15 Apr 21, the applicant transferred to the Air Force Reserve, and after counseling from his servicing detachment, scheduled duty to complete a good R/R year. On 16 Sep 22, the applicant requested to have his points recalculated. As a result of this request, the Air Reserve Personnel Center Points Management office adjusted the applicant's R/R date to reflect 7 May 21 to 6 May 22, and the duty performed during his active service until 14 Apr 21 would not count towards his R/R year. Based on documentation provided by the applicant and analysis of the facts, there is evidence of an error or injustice because the unsatisfactory year was not the applicant's fault.

APPLICANT'S REVIEW OF AIR FORCE EVALUATION

The Board sent a copy of the advisory opinion to the applicant on 6 Jan 23 for comment (Exhibit D), but has received no response.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

1. The application was timely filed.
2. The applicant exhausted all available non-judicial relief before applying to the Board.
3. After reviewing all Exhibits, the Board concludes the applicant is the victim of an error or injustice. The Board concurs with the rationale and recommendation of HQ RIO/IRO and finds a preponderance of the evidence substantiates the applicant's contentions. Therefore, the Board recommends correcting the applicant's records as indicated below.
4. The applicant has not shown a personal appearance, with or without counsel, would materially add to the Board's understanding of the issues involved.

RECOMMENDATION

The pertinent military records of the Department of the Air Force relating to APPLICANT be corrected to show he be awarded an additional ten (10) non-paid IDT points for R/R year 7 May 21 to 6 May 22; and this period is a year of satisfactory federal service.

CERTIFICATION
