APPLICANT'S REQUEST

His DD Form 214, *Armed Forces of the United States of Transfer or Discharge*, issued 18 Jun 69, be amended to include the Security Police Augmentee Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC).

APPLICANT'S CONTENTIONS

In 1968, he cross-trained into Security Police Augmentee duty. The correction will assist in attaining service connection for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) with the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA).

The applicant's complete submission is at Exhibit A.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The applicant is a former Air National Guard sergeant (E-4).

According to AF Form 910, *SSgt, and Sgt Performance Report*, for the period 26 Jan 68 through 18 Oct 68, Section II, *Duties*, the applicant's Primary, Duty and Controlled AFSC number and title reflect 58150, Parachute Rigger respectively. Section V, *Comments of Reporting Official*, reflect the applicant performed Security Police Augmentee duty.

On 18 Jun 69, according to DD Form 214, the applicant was released from a period of active duty and credited with 1 year, 11 months, and 26 days of active service. Block 23a, *Specialty Number and Title* reflect 58150, Parachute Rigger.

APPLICABLE AUTHORITY/GUIDANCE

Title 10, United States Code, Section 1168: Discharge or release from active duty: limitation; DoDI 1336.01, *Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214/5 Series)*; AFI 36-3202, *Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214/5 Series)*; DD Form 214 Total Force Personnel Services Delivery Guide. The DD Form 214 is prepared in accordance with the aforementioned publications and is used to record qualifying active duty service.

AIR FORCE EVALUATION

NBG/A1PP (Force Management) recommends denying the application. Based on a review of the documentation provided and analysis of the facts, there is no evidence of an error or injustice. There is no AFSC classification for Security Police Augmentee. In addition, credit for augmentee duty is not an authorized entry on the DD Form 214.

APPLICANT'S REVIEW OF AIR FORCE EVALUATION

The Board sent a copy of the advisory opinion to the applicant on 17 Jan 24 for comment (Exhibit D), and the applicant replied on 21 Feb 24. In his response, the applicant contended he submitted evidence of his security police duties. In further support of his request, the applicant provided a DVA rating decision, dated 30 Jan 96.

The applicant's complete response is at Exhibit E.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

1. The application was not timely filed. The Board notes the applicant did not file the application within three years of discovering the alleged error or injustice, as required by Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code, and Department of the Air Force Instruction (DAFI) 36-2603, *Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records (AFBCMR)*.
2. The applicant exhausted all available non-judicial relief before applying to the Board.
3. After reviewing all Exhibits, the Board concludes the applicant is not the victim of an error or injustice. The Board concurs with the rationale and recommendation of NGB/A1PP and finds a preponderance of the evidence does not substantiate the applicant's contentions. The Board took note of the applicant's contentions and response; however, there is no authorized classification for Security Police Augmentee, and credit for an unauthorized classification is not permitted on the DD Form 214. Therefore, the Board recommends against correcting the applicant's records.

RECOMMENDATION

The Board recommends informing the applicant the evidence did not demonstrate material error or injustice, and the Board will reconsider the application only upon receipt of relevant evidence not already presented.
