# APPLICANT'S REQUEST

The break-in-service following his separation from active duty and his appointment in the Air Force Reserve (AFR) be eliminated.

#### APPLICANT'S CONTENTIONS

His recruiter submitted his Palace Front paperwork three months prior to his separation from active duty as he intended to transition directly from active duty to the reserve. However, through no fault of his own, he was scrolled after his date of separation, which caused a break in service from 2 Sep 21 - 26 Sep 21.

# STATEMENT OF FACTS

The applicant is an Air Force Reserve major (O-4).

On 19 Jun 09, according to DD Form 214, *Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty*, the applicant entered the Regular Air Force and was separated on 1 Sep 21 in the grade of major (O-4).

On 27 Sep 21, according to Reserve Order Work-Product dated 7 Dec 21, the applicant's appointment to the Air Force Reserve (Scroll work-...) was approved by the Secretary of Defense.

#### AIR FORCE EVALUATION

ARPC/DPAR recommends granting the request. Based on the documentation provided by the applicant and analysis of the facts, there is evidence of an error or injustice. The applicant was separated from the Regular Air Force on 1 Sep 21. His appointment to the Air Force Reserve (Scroll Work P...) was approved by the Secretary of Defense on 27 Sep 21. The break-in-service between his separation from active duty and appointment into the Air Force Reserve was due to no fault of the applicant. Therefore, the break in service should be eliminated in accordance with the SAF/GCM policy granting the Board the authority to adjust the applicant's date of separation.

#### APPLICANT'S REVIEW OF AIR FORCE EVALUATION

The Board sent a copy of the advisory opinion to the applicant on 22 Jan 24 for comment (Exhibit D), but has received no response.

#### FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

- 1. The application was timely filed.
- 2. The applicant exhausted all available non-judicial relief before applying to the Board.
- 3. After reviewing all Exhibits, the Board concludes the applicant is the victim of an error or injustice. The Board concurs with the rationale and recommendation of ARPC/DPAR and finds a preponderance of the evidence substantiates the applicant's contentions. Therefore, the Board recommends correcting the applicant's records as indicated below.

#### RECOMMENDATION

The pertinent military records of the Department of the Air Force relating to APPLICANT be corrected to show that he was not released from active duty effective 1 Sep 21 but on that date, he was continued on active duty until 26 Sep 21, on which date he tendered his resignation, was discharged from all Regular Air Force appointments, and was released from active duty.
