**APPLICANT’S REQUEST**

His home of record (HOR) be changed from Illinois to Nevada.

**APPLICANT’S CONTENTIONS**

He no longer has any family members or connection to his outdated HOR in Illinois and needs to have his HOR updated to the current address used on his Record of Emergency Data.

The applicant’s complete submission is at Exhibit A.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

The applicant is a currently serving Air Force captain (O-3).

On 27 Jun 13, according to USAFA Form O-205, *Record of Acceptance, Obligation, Reimbursement, and Oath of Allegiance*, the applicant was appointed as a cadet in USAFA and certified his HOR as Illinois.

On 24 May 17, according to Special Order Work-Product dated 27 Mar 17, the applicant was ordered to extended active duty. His HOR is listed as Illinois.

**APPLICABLE AUTHORITY/GUIDANCE**

The Joint Travel Regulations (JTR), Appendix A, defines the HOR as the place recorded as the individual’s home when appointed, commissioned, enlisted, inducted, or ordered into a tour of active duty. The JTR further states that a member may only change the HOR if a break in service exceeds one full day. Additionally, in instances of a bona fide error where the place originally named at the time of current entry into the service was not in fact the actual home, the correction must be fully justified and the home, as corrected, must be the member’s actual home upon entering the service, and not a different place selected for the member’s convenience.

According to the DD Form 214 Personnel Services Delivery Guide, the HOR on USAFA Form O-2050, *Record of Acceptance, Obligation, Reimbursement, and Oath of Allegiance*, is used as the HOR on the DD Form 214 for USAFA graduates.

According to the Air Force Personnel Center myPers website, state residency is the home for the purposes of taxes as a member moves throughout their military career. While the state residence

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may be updated at any time by completing a DD Form 2058, *State of Legal Residence Certificate*, at the Military Personnel Flight (MPF), the HOR remains unchanged unless there is a break in service of at least one day.

**FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION**

1. The application was timely filed.
2. The applicant exhausted all available non-judicial relief before applying to the Board.
3. After a careful review of the applicant's contentions and the available evidence of record, the Board is not convinced the applicant has provided sufficient evidence to conclude he is the victim of an error or injustice. The HOR when the applicant entered EAD on 24 May 17, is listed as Illinois, and the applicant did not provide proof his HOR was recorded in error. In addition, the applicant did not have a break in service of more than one full day; therefore, a change to the applicant's HOR is not authorized. In view of the foregoing, the Board recommends against correcting the applicant's records.

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Board recommends informing the applicant the evidence did not demonstrate material error or injustice, and the Board will reconsider the application only upon receipt of relevant evidence not already presented.
