### APPLICANT'S REQUEST

His date of rank (DOR) to captain (O-3) be corrected to reflect 26 May 04.

### APPLICANT'S CONTENTIONS

His DOR to O-3 currently reflected in his records is incorrect.

The applicant's complete submission is at Exhibit A.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The applicant is an Air Force Reserve (AFR) colonel (O-6).

On 26 May 04, according to Special Order Work-Product the applicant, then a Regular Air Force first lieutenant, was promoted to the grade of captain (O-3), with a DOR of 26 May 04.

On 11 Sep 06, according to AF IMT 1288, *Application for Ready Reserve Assignment*, the applicant applied for assignment into the Air Force Reserve.

On 6 Oct 06, according to DD Form 214, *Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty*, the applicant was released from active duty in the grade of O-3 with a narrative reason for separation of Force Shaping – VSP. He was credited with 6 years, 4 months, and 11 days of active service.

On 22 Nov 06, according to Special Order Work-Product dated 2 Feb 07, his appointment in the Reserve of the Air Force in the grade of O-3 was approved by the Secretary of Defense (SecDef) and states break in service/adjusted service dates (TYSD/PSD/TFCSD).

On 8 Aug 24, his Military Personnel Database System (MilPDS) record, *Officer Reserve Grade History Report*, reflects his O-3 DOR: 11 Jul 04.

### AIR FORCE EVALUATION

ARPC/DPAR, recommends granting the applicant's request. Based on the documentation provided by the applicant and analysis of the facts, there is evidence of an error or injustice due to him not being properly scrolled into the Ready Reserve, which caused an adjustment to his DOR. The applicant separated from active duty on 6 Oct 06 under the Voluntary Separation Pay (VSP).

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Force Shaping Program and his appointment into the Air Force Reserve was approved by SecDef on 22 Nov 06. Due to this delay in scroll processing, he incurred a 46-day break in service, from 7 Oct 06 through 21 Nov 06. This break in service resulted in an adjustment to his DOR from 26 May 04 to 11 Jul 04.

## APPLICANT'S REVIEW OF AIR FORCE EVALUATION

The Board sent a copy of the advisory opinion to the applicant on 20 Jun 24 for comment (Exhibit D), but has received no response.

## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

1. The application was timely filed.
2. The applicant exhausted all available non-judicial relief before applying to the Board.
3. After reviewing all Exhibits, the Board concludes the applicant is the victim of an error or injustice. The Board concurs with the rationale and recommendation of ARPC/DPAR and finds a preponderance of the evidence substantiates the applicant's contentions. Therefore, the Board recommends correcting the applicant's records as indicated below.

## RECOMMENDATION

The pertinent military records of the Department of the Air Force relating to APPLICANT be corrected to show he was not released from active duty on 6 Oct 06, but on that date he continued to serve on active duty until 21 Nov 06, on which date he tendered his resignation, was discharged from all Regular Air Force appointments, and was released from active duty.
