APPLICANT'S REQUEST

Her reenlistment documents be corrected to show she was eligible for a selective retention bonus (SRB).

APPLICANT'S CONTENTIONS

When she reenlisted, she was under the impression her Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) was changed. Her duty AFSC was changed but not her control AFSC before she reenlisted. Once the error was identified, it was backdated and corrected. She would not have reenlisted on 15 Apr 24 if she had known this was not corrected. When she looked at her reenlistment contract, she noticed the bonus portion was not filled out. This was conveyed to her Military Personnel Flight (MPF) and it was corrected. When she did not receive her bonus, a CMS case was created but her bonus was denied stating her AFSC was not changed until 17 Apr 24.

The applicant's complete submission is at Exhibit A.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The applicant is a currently serving Air Force staff sergeant (E-5).

Signed by the applicant on 12 Apr 24, DD Form 901, *Reenlistment Eligibility Annex to DD Form 4, Section V, Certification by Members Authorized Selective Retention Bonus (SRB)*, does not indicate any bonus information.

On 15 Apr 24, DD Form 4, *Enlistment/Reenlistment Document-Armed Forces of the United States*, indicates the applicant reenlisted for six years.

AIR FORCE EVALUATION


AFPC/DPMSSM recommends granting the applicant's request to correct her records to show she reenlisted for five years and two months on 15 Apr 24 with entitlement to a zone A multiple 2.0

Work-Product



Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) in the 2A554C AFSC and all previous versions of her 15 Apr 24 reenlistment contract be void and removed from her records.

The applicant reenlisted on 15 Apr 24 for six years and three months; however, the maximum reenlistment period she was authorized was five years and two months. Due to this, the applicant's MPF was instructed to change the period of reenlistment. The reenlistment contract in the applicant's record is incorrect; however, her period of reenlistment in the personnel data base and the pay system is correct. Additionally, the applicant's Control Air Force Specialty Code (CAFSC) in her record was not on the SRB list when she reenlisted; therefore, she was denied the zone A SRB. Her record has now been corrected to reflect a CAFSC on the SRB list with an effective date of 17 Mar 24. Had this data been updated correctly at the time of her 15 Apr 24 reenlistment, she would have been entitled to a zone A multiple 2.0 SRB in the 2A554C CAFSC for five years.

APPLICANT'S REVIEW OF AIR FORCE EVALUATION

The Board sent a copy of the advisory opinion to the applicant on 13 Feb 25 for comment (Exhibit D) but has received no response.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

1. The application was timely filed.
2. The applicant exhausted all available non-judicial relief before applying to the Board.
3. After reviewing all Exhibits, the Board concludes the applicant is the victim of an error or injustice. The Board concurs with the rationale and recommendation of AFPC/DP3SP and finds a preponderance of the evidence substantiates the applicant's contentions. Specifically, the Board finds an error was made when she reenlisted because her record did not reflect the correct CAFSC. Therefore, the Board recommends correcting the applicant's records as indicated below.
4. The applicant has not shown a personal appearance, with or without counsel, would materially add to the Board's understanding of the issues involved.

RECOMMENDATION

The pertinent military records of the Department of the Air Force relating to APPLICANT be corrected to show on 15 Apr 24, she reenlisted for five years and two months with entitlement to a zone A multiple 2.0 selective retention bonus (SRB) in the 2A554C Control Air Force Specialty Code (CAFSC).
