APPLICANT'S REQUEST

His home of record (HOR) be changed from Walnut, CA to Diamond Bar, CA

APPLICANT'S CONTENTIONS

He sold his home with the current address when he moved to his first assignment in Nov 22. It is not his home anymore. The recruiter did not brief the importance of the home of record (HOR) before he enlisted. He was just asked for his address without explanation of what HOR is.

The applicant's complete submission is at Exhibit A.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The applicant is a currently serving Air Force senior airman (E-4).

On 6 Jun 22, according to the DD Form 4, *Enlistment/Reenlistment Document – Armed Forces of the United States*, the applicant enlisted in the Regular Air Force. The applicant's HOR is identified as Work-Product

On 11 Jul 22, according to the DD Form 1966, *Record of Military Processing – Armed Forces of the United States*, the applicant certified his HOR was Work-Product

APPLICABLE AUTHORITY

The Joint Travel Regulations (JTR), Appendix A, defines the HOR as the place recorded as the individual's home when appointed, commissioned, enlisted, inducted, or ordered into a tour of active duty. The JTR further states that a member may only change the HOR if a break in service exceeds one full day. Additionally, in instances of a bona fide error where the place originally named at the time of current entry into the service was not in fact the actual home, the correction must be fully justified and the home, as corrected, must be the member's actual home upon entering the service, and not a different place selected for the member's convenience.

AIR FORCE EVALUATION

AFPC/DPMLT recommends denying the application. Based on the documentation provided by the applicant and analysis of the facts, there is no evidence of an error or injustice. In accordance with the Joint Travel Regulation (JTR), Appendix A. Definitions & Acronyms, it states the HOR is the place recorded as the individual's home when commissioned, appointed, enlisted, inducted, or ordered into a tour of active duty. The applicant's DD FORM 4, prepared by the recruiting squadron and wet signed by the applicant on 6 Jun 22 indicates the HOR as **Work-Product**

APPLICANT'S REVIEW OF AIR FORCE EVALUATION

The Board sent a copy of the advisory opinion to the applicant on 12 May 25 for comment (Exhibit D) but has received no response.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

1. The application was timely filed.
2. The applicant exhausted other available administrative remedies before applying to the Board.
3. After reviewing all Exhibits, the Board concludes the applicant is not the victim of an error or injustice. The Board concurs with the rationale and recommendation of AFPC/DPMLT and finds a preponderance of the evidence does not substantiate the applicant's contentions. The HOR is the place recorded as the applicant's home when he enlisted. According to the DD Form 4, the current address listed is the applicants home address when he enlisted. Therefore, the board recommends against correcting the applicant's records.

RECOMMENDATION

The Board recommends informing the applicant the evidence did not demonstrate material error or injustice, and the Board will reconsider the application only upon receipt of relevant evidence not already presented.
