Review complete. From a medical perspective, I wouldn't recommend changing any element of this member's discharge. That recommendation does come with the caveat that I'm unfamiliar with some forms of relief service members can seek through the DRB. The working conclusion for this member was the pain/numbness in his left leg and arm were of a psychiatric origin rather than physical ailment. The numbness began 3ish days into BMT after going through the vaccination line. Member spent a weekend in the hospital and a robust workup did not reveal any ongoing physical issues. Mental health also gave input on the case and hypothesized member's issues were psychiatric in nature. I hope this is helpful in the adjudication of this member's case. Please let me/us know if further assistance is needed!
