APPLICANT REQUESTS: correction of his retirement points to reflect inclusion of service for points only performed for the following retirement periods:

- 4 – 5 March 2022 for the retirement year ending (RYE) 11 March 2022 (4 points)
- April 2022 - October 2022 for the RYE 13 November 2022 (30 points)
- January 2023 – March 2023 for the RYE 11 March 2023 (12 points)
- April 2023 – March 2024 for the RYE 11 March 2024 (50 points)
- April 2024 – June 2024 for the RYE 11 March 2025 (12 points)

 - 21 and 22 January 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 11 and 12 February 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 4 and 5 March 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 14, 15, and 16 April 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 6 retirement points
 - 20 and 21 May 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 3 and 4 June 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 8 and 9 July 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 4, 5, and 6 August 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 6 retirement points

- 13 and 14 October 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 3, 4, and 5 November 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 6 retirement points
 - 1 and 2 December 2023, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 21 January 2024, for 8 hours, totaling 2 retirement points
 - 3 and 4 February 2024, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 8, 9, and 10 March 2024, for 8 hours each, totaling 6 retirement points
 - 6 and 7 April 2024, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 18 and 19 May 2024, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - 1 and 2 June 2024, for 8 hours each, totaling 4 retirement points
 - All points total 108 retirement points
- DA Form 5016 (Retirement Accounting Statement) to be addressed in the service record

FACTS:

1. The applicant states, in pertinent part:

- Since he started receiving Veterans Affairs compensation he began drilling for "points only" but has not been credited for the training conducted
- He served honorably for 19 years but has no record of drill retirement points over the last 3 years
- He needs to be credited for the missing time

2. A review of the applicant's available service record reflects the following:

- Having prior enlisted service in the U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) and in the Regular Army, on 22 May 2012, he enlisted in the USAR and continued service through reenlistments
- DA Form 5016, dated 10 April 2025 shows the following:
 - For the RYE 11 March 2022, the applicant earned 54 inactive duty training (IDT) points, 15 membership points, and 14 active duty training (ADT) points, totaling 83 total retirement points creditable
 - For the RYE 13 November 2022, the applicant earned 10 membership points, totaling 10 total retirement points creditable
 - For the RYE 11 March 2023, the applicant earned 5 membership points, totaling 5 total retirement points creditable
 - For the RYE 11 March 2024, the applicant earned 15 membership points, and 24 ADT points, totaling 39 total retirement points creditable

- For the RYE 11 March 2025, the applicant earned 30 IDT points, 15 membership points, and 26 ADT points, totaling 71 total retirement points creditable

3. On 8 May 2025, the U.S. Army Reserve Command, Retirement Services Officer, provided an advisory opinion recommending approval of the applicant's request stating, in pertinent part, they reviewed the applicant's documents and determined he should be awarded 114 retirement points in accordance with Army Regulation (AR) 140-185 (Training and Retirement Point Credits and Unit Level Strength Accounting Records). Full administrative relief granted.

4. On 12 May 2025, the applicant was provided with a copy of the advisory opinion and afforded the opportunity to respond.

BOARD DISCUSSION:

After reviewing the application and all supporting documents, the Board determined relief was warranted. The applicant's contentions, the military record, and regulatory guidance were carefully considered. Based upon the facts and recommendations outlined in the USARC advisory opinion and the lack of any rebuttal of those recommendations submitted by the applicant, the Board concluded there was sufficient evidence of an error or injustice warranting granting the requested relief.

BOARD DETERMINATION/RECOMMENDATION:

The Board determined the evidence presented is sufficient to warrant a recommendation for relief. As a result, the Board recommends that all Department of Army records of the individual concerned be corrected by awarding retirement points for the following periods of service:

- 4 – 5 March 2022 for the retirement year ending (RYE) 11 March 2022 (4 points)
- April 2022 - October 2022 for the RYE 13 November 2022 (30 points)
- January 2023 – March 2023 for the RYE 11 March 2023 (12 points)
- April 2023 – March 2024 for the RYE 11 March 2024 (50 points)
- April 2024 – June 2024 for the RYE 11 March 2025 (12 points)

REFERENCE:

AR 140-185 (Training and Retirement Point Credits and Unit Level Strength Accounting Records), paragraph 3-3 (DA Form 1380) provides that the DA Form 1380 is utilized to record IDT performed by non-unit Soldiers under the jurisdiction of HRC who are attached for retirement points only to USAR Troop Program Units, Army National Guard units, or to another service or component for training. Only attached Soldiers are authorized to perform IDT with the exception of one annual physical health assessment each for medical and dental readiness when authorized by the command prior to the event.

a. Nonpaid DA Forms 1380 will not be entered into ADARS and will be forwarded to HRC for award of retirement points no later than the end of each duty month.

b. With regard to awarding of retirement points for IDT (Four-Hour Rule), Service Members will be awarded one point for each 4-hour period of IDT duty performed. Maximum of two points per calendar day applies to IDT duty. Duty must be 8 hours in duration to receive two points per day.
