APPLICANT REQUESTS: correction of her retirement points to reflect inclusion of service for points only performed for the retirement period of July 2023 for the Retirement Years Ending (RYE) 20 July 2023 (1 retirement point) and 31 July 2023 (4 retirement points).

APPLICANT'S SUPPORTING DOCUMENT(S) CONSIDERED BY THE BOARD:

- DD Form 149 (Application for Correction of Military Record)
- DA Form 1380 (Record of Individual Performance of Reserve Duty Training), dated 23 July 2023 showing she completed training on 20 and 21 July 2023, for 4 hours each, and 23 July 2023, for 8 hours, totaling 4 retirement points
- DA Form 1380, dated 24 July 2023 showing she completed training on 23 July 2023, for 4 hours, totaling 1 retirement point
- Army Service Center Response Letter notifying her that they are unable to process her DA Forms 1380 and referring her to the ABCMR for further assistance
- Email correspondence showing her attached DA Forms 1380 with signature from her unit leadership
- Memorandum, Subject: Non-credited points-only DA Forms 1380, dated 18 July 2024 wherein her unit leadership requests the ABCMR grant her request as the delay in processing of her retirement points was due to no fault of her own

FACTS:

1. The applicant states, in part:

- She is missing 5 retirement points for her last Battle Assembly after a 30-year career
- The DA Forms 1380 were completed and submitted to the certifying officer the same day her training was completed, however, the clerk failed to submit her forms to the U.S. Army Human Resources Command (HRC) causing them to fall outside the 30-day window
- The error was of no fault of her own and should be processed accordingly

2. A review of the applicant's service record reflects the following:

- On 28 January 1991, she enlisted as a Cadet in the Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC)
- A Memorandum, Subject: Appointment as a Reserve Commissioned Officer of the Army, dated 21 July 1993 was issued; in conjunction she accepted a Reserve commission and executed an oath of office
- On 21 August 2014, a Memorandum for Notification of Eligibility for Retired Pay at Non-Regular Retirement (20-Year Letter) was issued
- Orders Number 0004879578.00, dated 30 May 2023 was issued for placement on the U.S. Army Reserve Retired List, effective 1 August 2023
- DA Form 5016 (Chronological Statement of Retirement Points), dated 30 August 2024 shows:
 - For the RYE 20 July 2023 the applicant earned 103 Inactive Duty Training (IDT) points, 15 membership points, and 65 Active Duty Training (ADT) points, totaling 183 total retirement points creditable
 - For the RYE 31 July 2023 the applicant earned 2 IDT points, totaling 2 total retirement points creditable

BOARD DISCUSSION:

After reviewing the application, all supporting documents, and the evidence found within the military record, the Board found that relief was warranted. The Board carefully considered the applicant's record of service, documents submitted in support of the petition, and executed a comprehensive review based on law, policy, and regulation. The Board concluded that based on the letter provided by the applicant's unit, the error was due to no fault of the applicant. Therefore, the applicant's request for relief is granted.

BOARD DETERMINATION/RECOMMENDATION:

The Board determined the evidence presented is sufficient to warrant a recommendation for relief. As a result, the Board recommends that all Department of the Army records of the individual concerned be corrected by awarding the applicant qualifying retirement points for the Retirement Years Ending:

- 20 July 2023 (1 retirement point)
- 31 July 2023 (4 retirement points).

REFERENCES:

Army Regulation 140-185 (Training and Retirement Point Credits and Unit Level Strength Accounting Records), paragraph 3-3 (DA Form 1380) provides that the DA Form 1380 is utilized to record IDT performed by non-unit Soldiers under the jurisdiction of HRC who are attached for retirement points only to USAR Troop Program Units, Army National Guard units, or to another service or component for training. Only attached Soldiers are authorized to perform IDT with the exception of one annual physical health assessment each for medical and dental readiness when authorized by the command prior to the event.

a. Nonpaid DA Forms 1380 will not be entered into ADARS and will be forwarded to HRC for award of retirement points no later than the end of each duty month.

b. With regard to awarding of retirement points for IDT (Four-Hour Rule), Service Members will be awarded one point for each 4-hour period of IDT duty performed. Maximum of two points per calendar day applies to IDT duty. Duty must be 8 hours in duration to receive two points per day.

c. 3. Criteria for crediting retirement points - The limitations on the number of points that may be credited to a Soldier during an anniversary year are—

(1) Maximum—365 (366 during leap year) points.

(2) No more than one retirement point may be awarded for any day in which the Soldier is on active duty. A Soldier in active service may not receive retirement points for other activities performed concurrently.

(3) Retirement points credited for activities other than active service or funeral honors duty may not exceed—

- For any anniversary years closing before 23 September 1996: 60 retirement points
- For anniversary years closing on or after 23 September 1996 but before 30 October 2000: 75 retirement points
- For anniversary years closing on or after 30 October 2000 but before 30 October 2007: 90 retirement points
- For anniversary years closing on or after 30 October 2007: 130 retirement points
