FINAL DECISION BCMR Docket No. 2012-150



The applicant asked the Board to correct his record by to show that he enlisted in the Coast Guard Reserve on December 1, 2011. He stated that he was sworn into the Coast Guard on December 1, 2011, but that the first page of his enlistment contract erroneously shows that he enlisted on September 11, 2001. The applicant's military record contains an enlistment contract which shows the date of enlistment as September 11, 2011, on the first page, but subsequent pages of the contract are all dated December 1, 2011. His record also contains Annex L (Statement of Understanding) to his enlistment contract and it is also dated December 1, 2011.

The Judge Advocate General (JAG) of the Coast Guard recommended that the Board grant the applicant's request. In making this recommendation, the JAG adopted the findings and analysis in a memorandum provided by the Personnel Service Center (PSC). PSC stated that it confirmed with the applicant's recruiter than that the applicant signed his enlistment papers on December 1, 2011, and stated that the difference in dates on the contract was a clerical error.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

The record shows that the applicant enlisted in the Coast Guard Reserve on December 1, 2011. All of his enlistment papers are dated December 1, 2011, but the date on page one of his enlistment contract is erroneously listed as September 11, 2011. The JAG recommended granting relief and stated that the discrepancies in dates were caused by a clerical error. Accordingly, relief should be granted by correcting the applicant's record to show that he enlisted in the Coast Guard Reserve on December 1, 2011.
