**Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:**

DISCUSSION:

The applicant contends that the narrative reason on their DD-214 is in error.

Per ALCOAST 562/08, the use "Convenience of Government" or "Unsuitability" are not considered as narrative reasons from the Separation Program Designator handbook. Therefore, a separation summary may list (legacy Personnel Manual's 12-B-12) with Convenience of the Government in the Article/law, but it is not to be substituted, or used synonymously in block 28 of the DD-214 for Voluntary separations under the SPD code of KND, Separation for Miscellaneous/General Reasons.

Propriety: Discharge was proper.

Equity: Discharge was equitable.

Final Adjudication by Assistant Commandant For Human Resources: Discharge will stand as issued.

In reviewing discharges, the Board presumes regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs unless there is substantial credible evidence (to include evidence submitted by the Applicant) to rebut the presumption.
