**Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:**

**DISCUSSION:**

The applicant was discharged for Unacceptable Conduct. The Board utilized the Executive Officer's narrative for details on the means for discharge.

Despite the applicant's undesired behavior, the Board does recommend a partial upgrade to reflect that the applicant's troubles were performance-laden in a very short period of time (after 10 years of above average evaluations and advancing to E6). The Board does recognize the adverse impacts of the applicant actions, however the majority opinion among the panel is that the totality of service is best characterized as 'Satisfactory Performance'.

The applicant did waive the Administrative Separation Board afforded to those with over 8 years of service in order to receive an Honorable Discharge.

Propriety: Discharge was proper.

Equity: Discharge was not equitable.

In reviewing discharges, the Board presumes regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs unless there is substantial credible evidence (to include evidence submitted by the Applicant) to rebut the presumption.
