Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:

DISCUSSION:

The applicant was discharged for Failed Medical/Physical Procurement Standards. The time in service was less than 180 days that resulted in an Uncharacterized Discharge. The Board finds no issues with propriety or equity in this case.

The applicant was notified of the intent to discharge due to having a pre-existing medical condition that was not waiver-able for continued service.

An RE3 reentry code is not an affirmative recommendation for reenlistment, rather it represents that the applicant is not recommended for reenlistment due to a disqualifying factor. The RE3 code may be waived based upon the policies and needs of the gaining Service.

Propriety: Discharge was proper.

Equity: Discharge was equitable.

Final Adjudication By Assistant Commandant for Human Resources: Concur with Board. No relief.

In reviewing discharges, the Board presumes regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs unless there is substantial credible evidence (to include evidence submitted by the Applicant) to rebut the presumption.
