## **Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:**

## DISCUSSION:

The applicant was discharged for Unacceptable Conduct due to fraternization. The applicant was a former USCG officer that engaged in inappropriate relations with junior enlisted personnel under their supervision. The Board finds no issues with propriety or equity in this case. The Board notes the applicant's acknowledgment of the aforesaid offenses.

RECOMMENDATION: The Board members thoroughly reviewed the applicant's record of service and all available documentation. The Board deemed that the applicant's character of service, reason for separation and reenlistment code are appropriate and should not be changed. The applicant has not substantiated any error or inequity.

Propriety: Discharge was proper. Equity: Discharge was equitable.

Final Adjudication By Assistant Commandant for Human Resources: Concur with Board. No relief.
