Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:

DISCUSSION:

The applicant was discharged for the Narrative Reason of Triable By Court Martial.

Prior to discharge, the applicant was facing a General Court-Martial proceeding stemming from sexual assault charges. While the applicant professes their innocence, a Discharge 'For the Good of the Service' with an Under Other Than Honorable character of service was accepted in lieu of the military justice and proceeding and punishment.

The Board finds no issues with propriety or equity in this case.

RECOMMENDATION: The Board members thoroughly reviewed the applicant's record of service and all available documentation. The Board deemed that the applicant's character of service, reason for separation and reenlistment code are appropriate and should not be changed. The applicant has not substantiated any error or inequity.

Propriety: Discharge was proper. Equity: Discharge was equitable.

Final Adjudication by Assistant Commandant For Human Resources: No relief.

In reviewing discharges, the Board presumes regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs unless there is substantial credible evidence (to include evidence submitted by the Applicant) to rebut the presumption.
