**Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:**

DISCUSSION:

The applicant was discharged, with an Other Than Honorable discharge due to Misconduct specifically due to Commission of a Serious Offense.

The applicant was found guilty of driving under the influence with injury, gross bodily injury and child endangerment. The applicant struck a jogger causing major injuries while driving intoxicated and having a child as a passenger in the vehicle.

The Board finds no issues with propriety or equity in this case.

Propriety: Discharge was proper.

Equity: Discharge was equitable.

Final Adjudication By Assistant Commandant for Human Resources: Concur with Board. No relief.

In reviewing discharges, the Board presumes regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs unless there is substantial credible evidence (to include evidence submitted by the Applicant) to rebut the presumption.
