Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:

DISCUSSION:

The applicant was discharged for Misconduct due Involvement with Drugs.

This is their third submission to the Coast Guard Discharge Review Board (DRB). In their statement to the DRB, the applicant states that they were “documented as being a sleepwalker” a few months prior to their discharge and the “process of being discharged for this condition should have been started.....”. The DRB does not have the authority to recommend changes based on medical conditions.

The Applicant did not submit new evidence to refute their NJP proceedings that occurred.

Propriety: Discharge was proper.

Equity: Discharge was equitable.

Board Conclusion: The Board voted 5-0 to recommend no relief.

In reviewing discharges, the Board presumes regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs unless there is substantial credible evidence (to include evidence submitted by the Applicant) to rebut the presumption.
