**Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:**

**DISCUSSION:**

The Applicant was discharged. The Applicant's Character of Service is Under Other Than Honorable Conditions and the Narrative Reason is For The Good Of The Service.

The reason for their separation was due to misconduct which was heard at Special Court-Martial.

The applicant plead to Article 107 of the UCMJ involving False Statements. And Article 120 of the UCMJ involving Assault Consummated by a Battery. The applicant was sentenced to Reduction to E-3 and confinement for 60 days. The Applicant did not provide any information or evidence which would merit an increase to the type of discharge. The applicant was not present before the Board's proceeding.

Propriety: Discharge was proper.

Equity: Discharge was equitable.

Board Conclusion: The Board voted 5-0 to recommend no relief.

In reviewing discharges, the Board presumes regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs unless there is substantial credible evidence (to include evidence submitted by the Applicant) to rebut the presumption.
