**Discharge Review Board Discussion and Decision:**

DISCUSSION:

The Applicant was discharged with a Character of Service as Honorable and the Narrative Reason for Separation is Pattern of Misconduct.

The reason for the Applicant's separation was due to a pattern of misconduct with several violations of the UCMJ. The recurring nature of the offenses were considered collectively and that warranted the separation. The Administrative Separation Board noted eight (8) offenses which were considered in this pattern of misconduct. The Board concluded the discharge was equitable to the standard set forth.

Propriety: Discharge was proper.

Equity: Discharge was equitable.

Final Adjudication By Assistant Commandant for Human Resources: Concur with Board. No relief

In reviewing discharges, the Board presumes regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs unless there is substantial credible evidence (to include evidence submitted by the Applicant) to rebut the presumption.
