1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show he is entitled to an incentive allowance for moving his household goods (HHGs) under the "Do-It-Yourself" (DITY) Program.
2. The Board, consisting of Mses. Hardbower, Newman, and Mr. Geisler, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 17 October 2000 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
  - a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
  - b. After reviewing the correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the Board concluded that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

- a. BuPers order discharging Petitioner from active duty was issued on "26 January 2000" vice any other date.
- b. The Board approved the use of a constructive weight of 15,100 pounds for Petitioner's HHGs. Any entitlement accrued as a result of moving the HHGs will be based on 15,100 pounds.
- c. On 27 January 2000 he executed the appropriate documents where he voluntarily elected to participate in the DITY Program to move his HHGs; by endorsement dated 27 January 2000, authority to participate in the DITY Program was granted by the appropriate naval authorities and the documents were prepared to show government procured equipment to move the HHGs was obtained through the appropriate authorities and used by Petitioner vice that he personally obtained and used rental equipment.

(NOTE: Petitioner will forward a copy of this letter and a copy of any documents he may have pertaining to moving his HHGs to NAVTRANSPTCTR, 1667 Piersey Street, Code 14.2, Norfolk, VA 23511-2806.)

- d. That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
4. Pursuant to Section 6(c) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(c)) it is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.


