1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show he is entitled to payment of Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) for his assigned duty station.
2. The Board, consisting of Messrs, Kastner, McPartlin, and Ms. McCormick, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 16 October 2001 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
  - a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
  - b. After reviewing the correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the Board concluded that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. Petitioner was authorized BAH for his assigned duty station which was the University of Michigan Dental School, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48109 for the period 26 August 1996 through 26 April 2000. (NOTE: Petitioner was assigned to the Recruiting Detachment Detroit, MI with assigned duty station University of Michigan Dental School, Ann Arbor, MI. The Joint Federal Travel Regulations define duty station as the place the individual is attending a course of instruction.)

b. That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. Pursuant to Section 6(c) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(c)) it is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
