1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show the orders that released Petitioner from active duty were issued prior to 26 July 2004.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED], reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 22 September 2005 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In a telephone conversation with a representative from the NAVSUPSYSCMD, the representative commented that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. The orders that released Petitioner from active duty were issued on "20 July 2004" vice any other date.

b. On 20 July 2004 Petitioner submitted a letter to the appropriate naval authorities requesting authority to participate in the Personal Procured Move (PPM) program. On 20 July 2004 the appropriate naval authorities approved his request to participate in the PPM program.

(NOTE: Petitioner will forward a copy of this letter and a copy of all documents pertaining to the move to the Naval Transportation Support Center, Personal Property Audit Division, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED].)

c. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. Pursuant to Section 6(c) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(c)) it is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
