- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to establish entitlement to an Enlistment Bonus for Source Rate (EBSR).
- The Board, consisting of Mr. Zsalman, Mr. George, and Mr. Ruskin, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 4 August 2014 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

- a. Annex A to the DD Form 4 dated and signed now designated Annex B. This change establishes continuity in Petitioner's record.
- b. Annex A to the DD Form 4 dated and signed and signed is now designated Annex C. This change establishes continuity in Petitioner's record.
- c. Annex C to the DD Form 4 dated entitles entitles Petitioner to the following guarantees:
 - Option (1) Nuclear Field (NF 6YO) Program
 Option (2) Enlistment Bonus for Source Rate (EBSR) \$15,000 bonus

Note: Petitioner has numerous service record pages that are missing from his Official Military Personnel File (OMPF), which he included as part of his BCNR package. Copies of those missing pages are attached for inclusion in Petitioner's OMPF. Three (3) Annex "A"s to be corrected as directed above; copy of his DD Form 4/1 OCT 2007 and DD Form 4/2, OCT 2007 with DEP date of 20100629; copy of DD Form 1966/3, MAR 2007; Page 13 dated 21JUL10 - program change from AEF-AECF to NF-OPEN; Page 13 dated 21JUL10 - Nuclear Field Medical Statement of Understanding; NAVCRUIT 1133/102 (REV 2-10) - Enlistment Bonus Statement of Understanding for NF-OPEN signed and dated 21 July 2010; Statement of Understanding for NF-OPEN signed and dated 21JUL10 - Nuclear Field Program; Page 13 dated 21JUL10 - Nuclear Field Enlistment Bonus Statement of Understanding; Page 13 dated 21JUL10 - Nuclear Field Enlistment Bonus Statement of Understanding; Page 13 dated 21JUL10 - Nuclear Field Enlistment Bonus Statement of Understanding; Page 13 dated 21JUL10 - Nuclear Field Enlistment Bonus Statement of Understanding (Page 2); and Page 13 Nuclear Field Statement of Understanding signed and dated 21 July 2010.

- d. The Navy Personnel Command (PERS-811), PSD Charleston, or Ballston Spa, New York will pay the EB entitlement as appropriate (provided all EB criteria have been met).
- e. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
- 4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
