- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to authorize an entitlement to a Household Goods (HHG) Move.
- 2. The Board, consisting of reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 21 November 2016 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds that prior to applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

- a. Petitioner requested and was approved for an extension to the 180 day time limit to move his HHG on 27 March 2016. The Petitioner's extension was approved through 27 March 2017.
- b. In conjunction with his extension to move his HHG, Petitioner was approved for an extension to his storage entitlement through 27 March 2017.

- c. Note: Petitioner will contact the HHG-AT for adjudication of his HHG claim. A copy of this approval is required for adjudication.
 - d. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
- 4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's precedings in the above entitled matter
