1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to transfer points from one anniversary year to another.

- 2. The Board, consisting of reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 12 September 2017 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board agreed that Petitioner's anniversary date was identified in error upon entering the Marine Corps Reserves; due to no fault of the Petitioner. The Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

Subj: REVIEW OF NAVAL RECORD ICC USMCR

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

A total of 17 paid drill points be moved from anniversary year ending 23 May 2016 to anniversary year ending 23 May 2015. Note: this will make a total of 50 points which equals the minimum points required for a satisfactory year towards a reserve retirement.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
