- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the reference, Petitioner, an enlisted member of the Navy, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting removal from her record, the Detachment of Individual Evaluation for the reporting period 16 November 2016 to 22 May 2017.
- 2. The Board, consisting of least the state of least the Board consisted of naval records and applicable statutes, regulations and policies. reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 14 June 2017, and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of naval records and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
 - b. Enclosure (1) was filed in a timely manner.
- c. Petitioner was in receipt of Change Duty Orders with a projected detachment date of 22 May 2016. Her reporting senior (RS) submitted a Detachment of Individual Evaluation (Eval) for the reporting period 16 November 2016 to 22 May 2017 and the Eval was entered into her official military personnel file (OMPF). On 25 May 2017, she received an official cancellation of her Change Duty Orders and did not detach from her current command. New or modified orders have not been issued and she does not have a projected detachment date. Petitioner's next Periodic Evaluation is not due until November 2017.
- d. Petitioner contends that, because she did not detach from her current command, the Detachment of Individual Eval inserted into her OMPF is in error.

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board concluded that Petitioner's request warrants relief. In this regard, the Board noted that the contested Eval was submitted and entered into Petitioner's OMPF in anticipation of her detachment from her command on 22 May 2017. However, prior to executing her Change Duty Orders, the orders were cancelled and she did not detach from her current command. Further, there is no projected reporting occasion anticipated until her Period Evaluation is due in November 2017.

In view of the above, the Board directs the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

Petitioner's naval record be corrected by removing the Detachment of Individual Evaluation for the reporting period 16 November 2016 to 22 May 2017.

Any material or entries inconsistent with or relating to the Board's recommendation be corrected, removed or completely expunged from Petitioner's record and that no such entries or material be added to the record in the future.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulation, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
