1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to establish entitlement to an Enlistment Bonus for Source Rate (EBSR).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 12 January 2018 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action: The Petitioner signed an Enlistment Guarantee (Annex B) with an enlistment bonus in the amount of \$8,000. The Enlistment Guarantee (Annex B) should have reflected the Delayed Entry Program (DEP) date of 4 November 2014; however, an erroneous date of 5 February 2015 was entered. Due to this error, the Petitioner was not paid the \$8,000 enlistment bonus.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Annex B to the DD Form 4 is dated "4 November 2014", vice "5 February 2015". All other enlistment guarantees remain the same.

The Navy Personnel Command (PERS-811), PSD Charleston, or Ballston Spa, New York will pay the EB entitlement as appropriate (provided all EB criteria have been met).

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
