CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the court's order of former spouse coverage, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The Petitioner changed his Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) coverage from spouse to former spouse SBP coverage naming as the beneficiary, at the same level of coverage as previously elected, within one year of the date of his divorce (which was finalized on 11 March 2015). Any other election or declination executed by the Petitioner is null and void.

Note: This is in compliance with a court order.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
