- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Petitioner, an enlisted member of the Marine Corps, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting that his naval record be corrected by removing five (5) Administrative Remarks (Page 11) promotion restriction counseling entries from his Official Military Personnel File (OMPF).
- 2. The Board, consisting of reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 13 September 2017, and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below shall be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of the naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies. Enclosures (2) through (8) apply.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- b. Petitioner was issued enclosure (4) through (8), indicating, in part that he was eligible but not recommended for promotion to sergeant due to not completing the required professional military education (PME).

c. Petitioner states in part, that the Page 11s were erroneously entered into his OMPF without his knowledge. He submitted with his application enclosures (3) and (4), indicating that he completed the required PME courses prior to the issuances of the Page 11s, and prior to the periods of promotion restriction.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and in light of enclosures (3) and (4), the Board determined that Petitioner's request warrants favorable action. In this regard, the Board concluded that enclosures (4) through (8) shall be removed from his OMPF.

## RECOMMENDATION

In view of the foregoing, the Board finds the existence of an error and injustice warranting the following corrective action.

Petitioner's naval record be corrected by removing enclosures (4) through (8) from his OMPF.

Any material or entries inconsistent with or relating to the Board's recommendation be corrected, removed or completely expunged from Petitioner's record and that no such entries or material be added to the record in the future.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.



5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulation, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
