1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting that he be reimbursed for his household goods move to [REDACTED]

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 14 November 2017 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of Petitioner's application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board agreed that the Petitioner was told that his orders would be issued on 17 February 2017, the record should reflect the earlier order date, and Petitioner should be paid for his HHG move. The Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The Petitioner's PCS BUPERS Order number 0747 was issued on "7 March 2017" vice "15 March 2017".

The Petitioner is advised to resubmit his personally procured move (PPM) claim and a copy of this Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) decision letter to the Household Goods Audit Team (HHG-AT) for re-adjudication. Note: settlement of claim is chargeable to the line of accounting on the Petitioner's order number 0747.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
