- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to establish entitlement to a zone "C" Selective Reenlistment Contract (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 23 February 2018 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action: The Petitioner submitted for reenlistment with the intent to receive a Fiscal Year 2016 zone "C" SRB. Due to the delayed reenlistment review by Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps, the Petitioner received authorization to execute reenlistment after his 31 month extension became operative. Since the Petitioner's extension became operative, his request for reenlistment was administratively closed.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on or about 13/14December 2015, vice on or about 7/8 September 2017. The term is 4 years and 1 month vice 4 years.

This change upon completion of MOS training will entitle the letitioner to a zone "C" SRB for MOS 0689, which is capped a \$38,750 dollars for 48 months of additional obligated service. Remaining obligated service to 15 December 2015 will be deducted from SRB computation

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
